Gives some details on Ingleborough caves and potholes in the section 'Prehistoric Antiquities of Craven'. Details Hellen Pot (Alum Pot) descended in 1847. Later a bucket and windlass were erected and parties lowered down.

P.443 Clapdale Castle on the skirts of Ingleborough. Quotes Dodsworth 'Clapdale Castle hath been very large and strong' Builded by Adam de Staveley or one of his ancestors who sold the Chase of Ingleborough to Roger Mowbray in the time of John.

Dr Samuel Hailstone of Bradford contributed the catalogue of Craven plants.

Speight: his investigations were 'purely genealogical and historical.'

Binding: Hollett 'blind ruled and gilt, black morocco. The YAS copy rebound in red leather.
